## Passing the Torch

Following 28 years of leadership, Joan Chesler will retire as founding executive director of The Corner Health Center on June 30, 2009. We look forward to the opportunity to work with Ellen to carry on the important work of The Corner.

# Message from the Leadership

**The** Corner Health Center has grown steadily through the years. Established by community leaders in 1980 in response to high rates of teen pregnancy and infant mortality in Washtenaw County, The Corner began by providing basic health care to a few hundred teens out of two small rooms in the old Ypsilanti High School. Today, The Corner provides comprehensive medical care and support to thousands of young people out of two historic buildings in the heart of downtown Ypsilanti. The Corner has become a model of integrated physical and behavioral health care for adolescents. Since its inception, more than 18,000 young people ages 12 through 21, and their children have received medical care, health education and essential support services from The Corner.

In the past year, we made significant accomplishments. We successfully completed a capital campaign to expand our clinic and enhance our ability to serve our patients. We managed a budget sorely challenged by Michigan's weak economy. We filled several key staff positions and laid groundwork for a smooth transition in the office of the Executive Director.

With the enthusiastic leadership of a dynamic volunteer committee chaired by Jean Nelson and David Lutton, The Corner successfully completed its capital campaign. As this report goes to press, we have raised a total of \$1,735,794 in new gifts and pledges to extend our facilities into an adjoining building. We expect to occupy our new space in the summer of 2009.

Because our goal was met by September 30, 2008, we received a challenge grant of \$250,000 from the Kresge Foundation. As part of the renovations, the outside of our building was greatly enhanced with a student-painted mural dedicated to our clients—past, present and future. The colorful mural (opposite page) has increased our visibility in the community.

Though we successfully met our capital campaign goal, we struggled to balance our operating budget. The coming year will pose even greater challenges.

The accomplishments of the past year were achieved during a period of major personnel changes. During the course of the year, four key staff members left The Corner for career changes, relocations and educational opportunities. As a result, four new employees were brought on board to fill the positions of clinic director, finance director, development director and coordinator for our WIC and MIHP programs.

By far the most significant personnel change was set in motion by Joan's announcement that she will retire as founding executive director of The Corner at the end of June 2009. A transition committee embarked on a comprehensive, year-long process to identify her successor. The result was the selection of Ellen Clement, who has served as the director of the Washtenaw County Public Health Department since 1996. Ellen will begin work at The Corner in mid-May 2009. She comes to us with an extensive record of achievement in community health initiatives, outstanding collaborative relationships with local

agencies, institutions, and community leaders, and an impressive commitment to public health. We anticipate that a smooth and successful transition will occur later this year.

The Corner Health Center is Michigan's oldest, largest and most comprehensive teen health center. With the support and involvement of many compassionate and committed members of our community, we are meeting the needs of thousands of young people for high-quality, affordable health care in a non-judgmental, teen-friendly environment. With your help, we will continue in this important endeavor for as long as the need exists. Please accept our heartfelt thanks.

1980 – The Corner is incorporated.

1993 – Education Director Eleanor Anasar authors three booklets for parents raising infants and toddlers. The booklets are translated to Spanish and marketed nationally.

After 28 years at the helm of The Corner Health Center, I will retire at the end of June 2009. As I prepare for the transition, I’ve been reminiscing about how The Corner has evolved.

The Corner was founded upon the belief that all youth have a right to high quality, affordable health care and that young women in particular should be able to control their own reproductive health with access to safe, confidential birth control and maternal health care services. What started as a “mom and pop shop” led by me and Dr. David Share has grown into an important community and statewide resource. I am grateful to the many wonderful people who have provided guidance and support along the way. I’d like to mention a few.



David Share, 1981

The Corner was incorporated in 1980 under the leadership of Nancy Margolis. We occupied a small space in the old Ypsilanti High School

and took our name from our location in the school’s southeast corner. The Corner was established with the help of dedicated community leaders. Dr. John Atwater led the health department’s support. Dr. Johan Eliot from the UM School of Public Health enthusiastically served on our first board as did Carole Rycus, still a Board member.

The Corner Theatre Troupe was established in 1982 to provide peer health education. From the start, Eleanor Anasar has successfully guided the Troupe and secured its funding. Over the years we added other peer health education programs. From 1983 to 1989, we trained teen mothers to serve as clinic assistants and to speak in schools. One former peer educator, Lori Partin, still works for The Corner as our receptionist, patient advocate and insurance specialist. Another former peer educator, Nannette White, has served on our board for many years.

In 1987, the State of Michigan began funding teen health centers with the condition that

they not provide family planning services on school property. Dr. James Hawkins, a strong supporter of The Corner, was superintendent of the Ypsilanti Public Schools at that time. This new proviso, coupled with The Corner’s need for additional space, prompted the Board to purchase an historic building in downtown Ypsilanti. I remember a board meeting chaired by Tom Daniels on a chilly Saturday morning, March 1, 1987 at 47 N. Huron. There were no chairs, so we all sat on the floor! The Board decided to purchase the building.

Mary Whiting provided leadership to help us add WIC services in 1990, and our WIC caseload doubled that year. Overcrowded again, we added our second building in 1991. The store front was rented to Rev. Don

Shelby and the Burning Bush Church of God in Christ until we could renovate and occupy the first floor.

1994 – HIV testing and counseling begin at The Corner.

1996 – The Corner Store opens.

1999 – The Corner launches a Food Pantry and the Patient Assistance Fund.

2002 – A second strategic plan is developed. The staff now numbers about 20.

2007 – Capital Campaign for building expansion and renovation begins.

2008 – Capital Campaign successfully concludes having raised \$1.7 million.

1995 – Mandated MCaid managed care comes to Michigan and The Corner. The Corner hires a triage nurse and begins helping patients apply for insurance.

1997 – The Corner develops its first strategic plan and hires its first development director.

2006 – WCHO places a foster care case manager and a social worker on site to provide crisis counseling and short term therapy. Two UM psychiatrists begin caring for patients once a week at The Corner.

2009 – Construction for building expansion and renovation begins. Founding executive director Joan Chesler retires. A new executive director begins.

In 1997, working with Anne Glendon, we developed our first strategic plan. In 1999 we hired Barb Sullivan, who helped bring the clinic and business functions together. Today she's managing our latest expansion and renovation project.

Strengthening our mental health services has been very dear to my heart. In 2006, Dr. Maria Muzik became one of two University of Michigan psychiatrists caring for patients at The Corner. She started our parenting education group, "Mom Power," to address young mothers' needs for support and a better understanding of child development.

Throughout the years, we've celebrated milestones. To mark our 15th anniversary, we held a clown party for kids and their families. Our 20th anniversary was celebrated with an elegant dinner party. Rannie Riecker, then

president of the Towsley Foundation, a very generous and loyal supporter of The Corner, addressed the guests. Our 25th anniversary was celebrated by 300 people. Photos from those events remind me of how much fun they were.

By 2006, we were again overcrowded and purchased the next building on our block at 57 N. Huron. To fund the expansion and renovation, we launched a capital campaign that raised \$1.7 million dollars by the end of September 2008. The successful campaign was chaired by Jean Nelson and David Lutton with additional leadership from Anne Glendon and Norman Herbert.

So many people have enabled The Corner to thrive!

Though I can't possibly thank each of you here individually, please know that I value your support enormously and have enjoyed working with you. I am deeply grateful for the 28 years of fun, support, creativity, energy, collaboration and wisdom that we have shared. Though I will miss the daily interaction with Corner

# The Corner Health Center: Providing Quality Health Care



**At** The Corner Health Center, we work hard to ensure that no young person in our community goes without medical care. In 2008 we helped more than 1,600 young people who visited more than 6,800 times for medical care and support services.

The Corner Health Center is a vital resource for low-income young people in the community. About 62% of our patients are covered by Medicaid. A small number has private insurance that they choose not to use so that they maintain the privacy of their reproductive health care. These patients pay on a sliding fee scale. In 2008, our patient advocate helped 427 uninsured patients apply for health insurance; 221 subsequently received insurance coverage.

**About** half of our patients are African American. Just over 40% are Caucasian. The rest are Asian, Hispanic, of mixed racial heritage, or identify themselves as “other”.

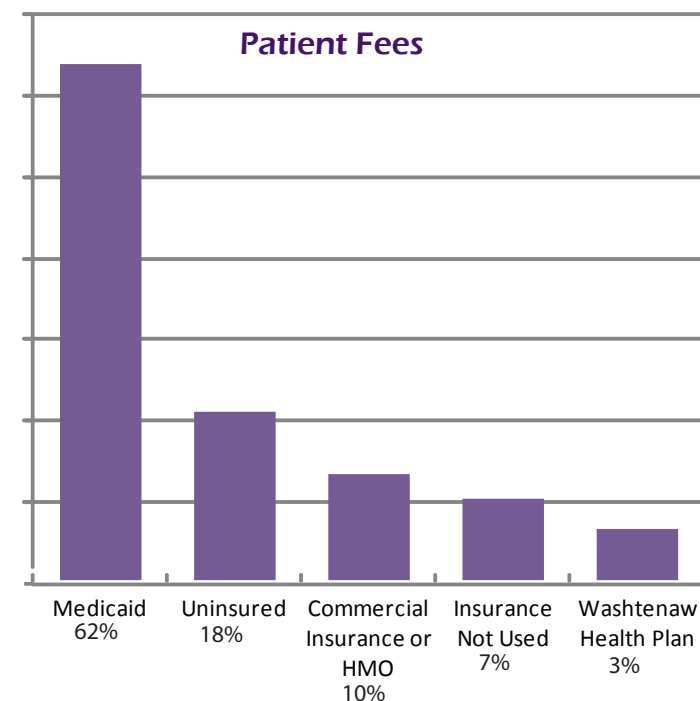
Adolescents between the ages of 12 and 21 account for 80% of our patients. Infants and toddlers make up 16% of our patients. The remaining few are between the ages of 5 and 12, or over 21.

94% of babies born to Corner patients in 2008 were delivered at normal birth weights. With our recently purchased obstetric ultrasound machine, we performed 170 ultrasounds for pregnant patients.

Our mental health services grew significantly in 2008. Fifteen percent of all Corner patients were seen at least once by Corner psychiatrists and/or social workers for mental health reasons.

While less than one percent of our patients were treated for sexually transmitted infections last year, many more are considered to be at risk. This number is alarming and represents a clear and continuing need in our community for access to testing for STIs and education on how to prevent their spread.

While 62% of our patients are served by Medicaid, Medicaid reimbursements cover only about 40% of our actual costs.



# The Corner Health Center: Educating and Supporting Young People

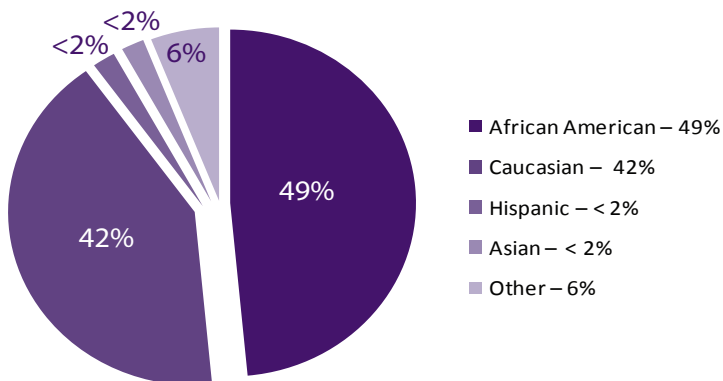


A Women, Infants and Children Supplemental Food Program (WIC) provides food benefits, nutrition education and surplus food to low-income pregnant and parenting women and their children. Last year, we helped 1,659 WIC clients.

The Corner Store is an incentive program that rewards patients for obtaining clinical services, especially preventive services such as health maintenance exams, well-child visits, immunizations and prenatal care. In 2008, more than 500 patients redeemed points for merchandise at The Store, including baby essentials and personal care items.

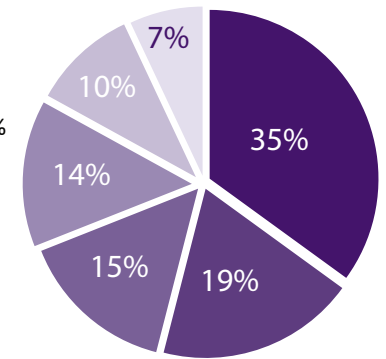
The Corner's Food Pantry helps to ensure that our most needy patients get the food they need to stay healthy. Food from the Pantry is free to all patients, who may take one grocery bag of food at each visit as needed. We purchase surplus food from Food Gatherers and are grateful for other contributions. In 2008, The Corner's Food Pantry provided food to 1,797 people in 542 households.

**The** Maternal and Infant Health Program (MIHP) is a support program for pregnant and parenting teens. MIHP provides coordinated nursing, social work and nutritional services for Medicaid-eligible pregnant and postpartum women. In 2008, The Corner provided support for 201 MIHP patients in 582 visits.

**The** Patient Assistance Fund helps young people pay for urgent transportation to and from The Corner or medical facilities, as well as prescription drugs and emergency medical needs not covered by insurance. In 2008, The Patient Assistance Fund helped more than 120 patients.

The Corner Theatre Troupe is a group of high school peer educators who give interactive, educational performances on topics including the prevention of dating violence, depression, HIV and STI's, and substance abuse. In 2008, Troupe members gave 54 performances and facilitated 79 follow up workshops that were attended by 1,730 young people and 35 adults in 20 locations including area middle and high schools.

Outright gifts of cash are as quick and easy as writing a check. Long-term appreciated stocks or bonds are the simplest and most frequently used alternative.

Honorary or memorial giving is a popular option. Celebrate the lives and achievements of special

individuals by making a gift in their honor or memory.

Gifts in kind of non-monetary items of tangible personal property or other physical assets, such as baby and teen items for The Corner Store or food items for The Corner's Food Pantry, are welcome.

Life insurance policies with cash surrender value are another gift option. Donors who no longer need death benefits can discover hidden assets in paid-up life insurance policies. By donating the life insurance policy to us, you receive an income tax deduction for the surrender value, avoid the need for any subsequent premium payments, and remove death benefits from a possibly taxable estate.

A bequest made in your will or living trust may be a method for giving to The Corner. There are additional methods by which you can plan now for a deferred gift to benefit The Corner, while reducing your tax liability and preserving a greater share of your estate for your heirs.

### December's Story

As she sits in her office in the Judson Center in Ann Arbor, December Venson reflects on her life. "I've always been ambitious," she says. At age 31, December works as a case manager for foster children. She counsels young people and works to find them safe placements. She represents them in court. She often refers her clients to The Corner Health Center for family planning and other services. December is especially committed to helping young people in crisis. She knows firsthand what it's like to be a teenager in trouble.

As a student at Willow Run High School, December thought she had her life mapped out. Living with her mother, she maintained good grades and was active in cheerleading and volleyball. She dreamed of becoming a social worker. At age 16, December had been accepted to Clark Atlanta University, a historically black school in Georgia. She was planning to major in sociology. Then, she discovered she was pregnant.

Becoming a teenage mom was not part of December's plans. She was afraid her mother would be furious, and without family support, there was no way she could move to Atlanta and enroll in college. How would she take



care of a child and attend school? How would she support herself and a baby? What kind of a life would she have? As she feared, when December shared the news, her mother was shocked, disappointed and very angry. December was told to leave the house.

"I felt exhausted," says December. "I was pregnant and alone, and I knew I needed help." She dropped out of school and moved in with her father and stepmother in Detroit. A doctor referred her to The Corner Health Center for her prenatal care. At The Corner, she was seen by an obstetrician, nurses and a social worker. A patient advocate helped her apply for Medicaid.



## Patients Succeed!

A nutritionist enrolled her in WIC, the supplemental nutrition program for Women, Infants and Children, and gave her coupons to purchase healthy food.

“The Corner became my refuge. During my visits, I never felt judged or uncomfortable,” recalls December. “Each time I went in, I was greeted by a warm and welcoming face. I was delighted that The Corner was professionally run and provided services to meet my needs.” December gave birth to a healthy baby girl. “I’m so thankful to The Corner for that,” she says.

Shortly after her daughter was born, December moved back to Ypsilanti with her baby, and into her first apartment. She found a full-time job as a clerk in a real estate office and returned to high school part-time. When December went to work, her daughter went to daycare, but she took her baby with her to classes. Somehow, she managed to graduate on time with the rest of her class.

With her diploma in hand, December enrolled at Washtenaw Community College. After two years, she earned her associates degree and was accepted at Eastern Michigan University. “Being a teen mother, working full-time and

going to school was very stressful,” she reports, “but I was determined to make a way for my daughter and me.” The hard work paid off. In 2007, December graduated with honors from EMU with a bachelor’s degree in sociology and psychology. Today, December is married and has a second daughter. In addition to working at the Judson Center, she has been studying for her master’s degree in Sociology, which she completed in April.

Experience has taught December Venson valuable life lessons. “I

encourage all young people to be as ambitious as I am,” she declares. “I would tell all teens to make use of the resources provided by The Corner, especially young women who are walking in my shoes,” she adds.

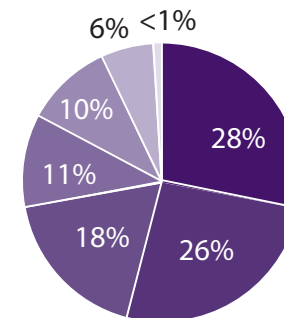
“I don’t condone teen pregnancy,” she continues, “but I believe that supporting teens who become pregnant is essential. Being a teen mom doesn’t mean you can’t do all you want to; it just makes getting there harder.”

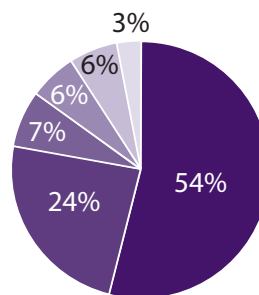

# Capital Campaign Update

**In 2008,** The Corner Health Center successfully completed its capital campaign, Caring for the Next Generations: Healthy Teens Today and Tomorrow. Thank you to the many donors and volunteers who helped to make our campaign a success!

The primary purpose of the campaign was to purchase an historic building immediately adjacent to The Corner's existing facilities, adding needed space for patient exam rooms, counseling and support services, and program space. Our original goal was to raise \$1.5 million for capital improvements, endowment and general operating support. Because interim construction cost projections were higher than anticipated, our campaign goal was increased in February 2008 to \$1.64 million.

## Success

Our goal was met in time to qualify for a \$250,000 challenge grant from The Kresge Foundation. As of September 30, 2008, The Corner had raised \$1,695,652 in new gifts and pledges for its campaign! At the time of this publication, the total has increased to \$1,735,794. Construction on the new space has begun. Demolition of the interior of the newly acquired building began in January 2009. Renovation is expected to be completed by summer 2009.

## Impact

The process of planning for and executing a facilities expansion as well as a capital campaign has helped The Corner Health Center to become a more strategic organization. During the campaign, The Corner initiated an organizational and financial analysis of its programs that was completed by the Fieldstone Alliance and the Nonprofit Finance Fund with a grant from the Kellogg Foundation. This analysis has been used by The Corner's Board in strategic planning and will help The Corner to prepare a comprehensive

business plan. Such analysis and planning will serve our agency well in many areas as we move forward.

We anticipate that heightened community awareness of The Corner Health Center resulting from the campaign will lead to opportunities for collaborative partnerships and community support. We have strengthened existing relationships and begun new ones. About one third of the donors to the campaign are new to The Corner, including a number of new donors from Ann Arbor who had not previously supported an Ypsilanti-based organization. We are committed to keeping all of our donors and friends, old and new, engaged and involved in our progress.

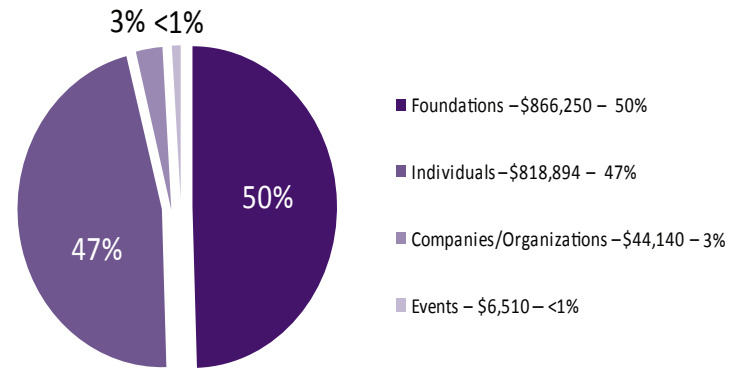
## Thank you!

The success of the campaign was celebrated at an open house at The Corner on September 24, 2008. About 150 donors, volunteers and community members attended.

At the open house, a large, outdoor wall mural commissioned as part of the expansion project was unveiled. The colorful, 48-foot wide by 8-foot tall mural now graces the south side of our building, a location visible from our street in the heart of downtown Ypsilanti. Executed by local high school art students under the direction of Mary Thiefels ([www.treetownmurals.com](http://www.treetownmurals.com)), the mural is dedicated to past, present and future young people who receive The Corner's services. The mural provides attractive public art that enhances the neighborhood and a much-needed landmark to identify The Corner Health Center and increase its visibility.

When our expansion and renovations are completed in 2009, we will have a grand opening to show off our new space and recognize those who have made it possible.

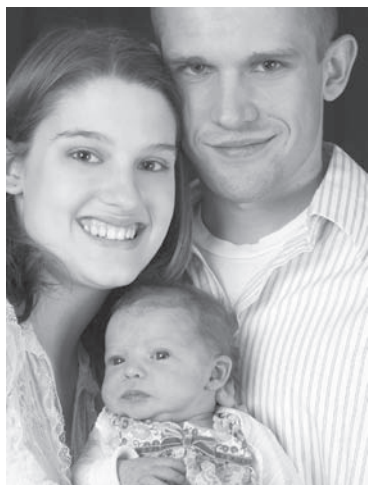
